Trekking Attire for the Forest

Your trekking clothing should prioritize comfort, protection and quiet refinement. Lightweight, breathable long-sleeved tops are essential for shielding arms from vegetation and insects while maintaining temperature balance in humid forest conditions. Neutral

tones such as olive, stone, taupe or soft grey blend naturally into the environment and reflect a discreet luxury aesthetic.

Trousers should be lightweight yet durable, offering flexibility for stepping over roots and navigating uneven ground. Fabrics that dry quickly and allow movement without restriction ensure comfort throughout the trek. A soft insulating mid-layer is recommended for early mornings and cooler elevations, particularly in Bwindi or Volcanoes National Park.

Footwear: Foundation of Comfort

Footwear is the single most important element of your packing. Waterproof trekking boots with good ankle support provide stability on muddy, uneven trails and significantly reduce fatigue. Boots should be fully broken in before travel, ensuring familiarity and comfort from the first step.

High-quality moisture-wicking trekking socks are equally important, helping regulate temperature and prevent friction. Packing more than one pair allows for fresh comfort after the trek.

Weather Protection and Outer Layers

Rain is a natural part of the rainforest environment and should be anticipated year-round. A lightweight, breathable waterproof jacket offers reliable protection without adding bulk. Wind resistance is also valuable, particularly at altitude or during early morning starts.

A structured cap or brimmed hat provides additional protection from rain and sun while improving visibility along forest paths.

Accessories That Elevate the Experience

A small, well-designed daypack is ideal for carrying water, personal items, and camera equipment. It should sit comfortably against the body and allow easy access without disrupting movement. Many guests also choose to hire a local porter, allowing them to trek hands-free and fully immersed in the experience.

Light trekking gloves can be helpful for gripping vegetation on steeper sections, while optional gaiters provide added protection against mud during wetter months.

Photography and Personal Technology

Gorilla trekking offers extraordinary photographic moments, often at close range and in low-light forest conditions. A compact camera or mirrorless system is ideal, paired with a

protective waterproof cover. Mobile phones should be stored in waterproof cases or dry bags to protect against moisture.

A portable power bank ensures devices remain charged throughout the day, particularly for photography enthusiasts.

Health, Wellness, and Personal Care

Any personal medications should be packed in original containers and carried in hand luggage. While luxury lodges provide comprehensive amenities, travelers may wish to bring personal comfort items such as blister care, mild pain relief, or preferred wellness essentials.

Insect repellent and sunscreen should be gentle on the skin yet effective, particularly during transfers, forest edges, and time spent outdoors at the lodge.

Lodge Wear and Evening Comfort

Evenings on an Elevana safari are relaxed and elegant. There is no need for formal attire; comfort and understated sophistication are key. Soft, breathable clothing allows the body to unwind after the trek, while a light sweater or jacket is useful for cool evenings by the fire.
